

RESOLUTION

URGING CONGRESS TO IMPEACH THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, BARACK HUSSEIN OBAMA, FOR HIGH CRIMES AND MISDEMEANORS AS IS THEIR DUTY UNDER ARTICLE II SECTION 4 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES.

Whereas the meaning of "High Crimes and Misdemeanors" refers to those punishable offenses that only apply to high persons, that is, to public officials, those who, because of their official status, are under special obligations that ordinary persons are not under, and which could not be meaningfully applied or justly punished if committed by ordinary persons;

Whereas the President of the United States of America is bound by his oath in all matters until he leaves office;

Whereas the purpose of the Constitution of the United States is to establish Justice, insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity;

Whereas the history of the current President of the United States is that of repeated injuries, all having in direct object the usurpation of the rights of the Citizens, the States and the Sovereignty of the same;

Whereas he has erected a multitude of New Offices, accountable only to him and not confirmed by the Senate as prescribed by Art II Sec. 2 Cl. 2;

Whereas he has allowed negotiations with enemies of the United States for the exchange of prisoners and that this was done without consulting Congress, which holds the authority to determine whether or not Guantanamo detainees can be released;

Whereas he has refused to protect our borders by continuing to allow undocumented and illegal persons to enter into the United States;

Whereas the President and his Attorney General Eric Holder have clearly violated their oath of office by joining with foreign countries such as Mexico, Bolivia, and Columbia in lawsuits against the sovereign states of Arizona, Georgia, and Alabama to stop them from enforcing the federal immigration laws;

Whereas thousands of acres of national parks in border States are closed and off limits to US Citizens due a marked increase in violence as a direct result of human and drug trafficking on the US border and the failure of the President to treat this takeover of sovereign land as an Act of War;

Whereas although the United States Senate refused to pass the Cap and Trade bill, the President has ordered the Environmental Protection Agency to use regulations to implement key portions of the bill in direct defiance of the will of the people, Congress, and the Constitution of the United States;

Whereas the President, through the Department of the Interior, has placed a moratorium on offshore oil drilling, and has prohibited new drilling exploration of federal land in direct defiance of several court orders issued by Federal Judge Feldman in New Orleans who declared that the department had no authority to issue such a moratorium;

Whereas the President has ordered the Federal Communications Commission to adopt regulations giving the federal government control of the internet and its contents, including providing the President the authority to shut down the internet if he sees fit in direct violation of a decision by the United States Supreme Court that the FCC has no Constitutional authority to control the internet;

Whereas the President has unilaterally declared the Defense of Marriage Act passed by the Congress unconstitutional and further declared that he would not have the Justice Department defend it against lawsuits;

Whereas the President has also refused to enforce laws against voter intimidation and federal law that requires States to purge their voter registration lists of deceased individuals and those registered illegally;

Whereas the President has used executive orders and administrative actions by his departments to nationalize and control automobile manufacturers, banks, insurance companies and portions of the healthcare industry with no Constitutional authority to do so;

Whereas it is recognized that the House of Representative's ability to impeach the President is distinguishable from the Senate's authority to remove the President from office; now, therefore be it

Resolved; 1 That the Constitution Party of New Jersey hereby strongly urges the United States Congress to impeach the President of the United States Barack Hussein Obama for High Crimes and Misdemeanors as is their duty under Article II Section 4 of the Constitution of the United States;

2 That the Secretary or his representative is hereby authorized and directed to transmit duly certified copies of this resolution to the National Secretary of the Constitution Party, the President of the United States, the Senate Majority Leader, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives and each member of Congress in the US House and Senate from the state of New Jersey.
